Kinhaven's skilled teachers support both established and blossoming friendships, using the classroom as a base for engaging experiences that promote social interactions and set the scene for collaborative work and play.

creative EXPRESSION

Children explore new and familiar media such as watercolor, pastels, clay, weaving, papier-mâché, and woodworking. Weekly sing-alongs promote the joy and community spirit of shared musical experiences.

neighborhood CONNECTIONS

Our urban setting affords possibilities for walkabouts to visit local merchants and professionals related to the topic at hand. Each session at Camp Kinhaven also features a guest presenter such as a naturalist or entertainer.

outdoor EXTENSIONS

Each session at Camp Kinhaven features a theme around which age-appropriate experiences are planned, both outdoors and in the various learning centers of the classroom.

Into the Woods

Session I; June 18 - July 6
Camp is closed July 4

Beginning your summer with a stay-cation? Give your child a trip Into the Woods. We shall nurture an appreciation of forests as we meet woodland creatures, plant and care for trees, and trace the origins of many everyday products. Beginning carpentry, wood (glue) constructions, paper making, seed art, and jam-making are a few of the "tree-ts" of the first session of Camp Kinhaven.

Water, Water Everywhere

Session II, July 9 - 27

For many summer isn't the same without water sports such as swimming, boating, or fishing. Explore water and waterways, the plants and animals within it, and the variety of ways humans interact with water. Campers will follow the water cycle from raindrop to waterway to the tap. Session II will be a gusher; students are sure to leave with an increased awareness of this valued resource.

City Safari

Session III; July 30 - August 17

Session III offers a closer look at the inner workings of local services such as public safety, trash and recycling, health, and public libraries as our classrooms are transformed and children take on new roles for those visiting from other classes. Join us on our City Safari.

Registration Procedures

Registration forms will be processed in the order they are received. A registration fee and \$175/session non-refundable deposit must be paid at time of registration. The balance is due no later than May 1. *Campers must be thirty months of age, or older, by June 1, 2018. Tuition based on child's age on June 1, 2018.*

A Typical Day

Class Meetings

Provide the framework for the day as children and teachers greet one another- often in song, discuss the topic of the day, and choose a primary area of work for the morning.

Work Time

Encompasses a protracted period of play including individual and small group play devised by children as well as thematically relevant experiences designed by the teachers for small groups of children

Meals

Children and teachers share a morning snack including fresh produce, and later in the day lunches brought from home.

Outdoor Time

Summer affords nearly every experience to be conducted outdoors, weather permitting! Playground, sprinklers, painting, gardening, games, bubbles and more.
